Boat Builders: Island People**June 7-18**

From kayaks to shrimp boats, Beaufort is surrounded by rivers filled with sea crafts. The Gullah people of the barrier islands built their own boats, as did the Port Royal shrimp fishermen. We will look at boat making's exciting history, meet real sea Captains, and create boats of our own. There will be basic woodworking skills learned (hammering & sawing), as well as lessons in our water world ecology. A field trip will round out our boat building adventure.

Exploring the Night Sky**June 21-July 2**

Using Astronomy as our guide, we will look to our summer sky as an inspiration for daily activities.

Taking stories from Ancient Greek Mythology and looking to the marvels of contemporary science, the children will learn to identify constellations in our Milky Way through fun projects. We will create a celestial mural painting, go on a night sky outing, and learn why the Big Dipper is the stargazer's most useful summer pattern. Star Charts will be purchased for a small fee.

Medicine Man**July 5-16 (Closed July 5th)**

This is a workshop for young artists. Looking at local plants and animals, the children will work with clay to make their own sculptures. We will learn about our favorite creatures and the animal spirits in all of us. Songs, stories, and dance will be part of the program. Field trips to meet local artists and gardening will make this a magical session.

Fiesta Latino Americana**July 19-30**

¡Damas y Caballeros! Your elementary child will explore Latin America through games, arts, crafts and music! We will immerse ourselves in the world of Spanish speaking countries and learn the differences in their cultures and traditions!! From Mexico to La Patagonia in Chile and Argentina, there is a world to explore!

General Information

- * Sessions are open to rising **1st through 4th** grade students.
- * Hours are from **8:30 to 3:00** (early & after care available)
- * Parents will need to send a lunch box with drink each day.
- * Each session costs \$150.00 per week (early care / after care are an additional \$50—total)
- * A minimum enrollment of 8 children is required for each session. Refunds will be given only in the event that minimum enrollments are not met.
- * Summer camp programs will include daily exercise activities, gardening activities, snacks, share time and a mellow time, as our days will be filled with a lot of action.

Instructors

- * The Programs are directed by ECM's Enrichment Coordinator, Steve Johnson. Mr. Johnson has a Bachelor in Fine Art from The Kansas City Art Institute, a degree in Horticulture from the Brooklyn Botanical Garden, and has completed the U.S. Coastguard's sea captain training. He was also a naturalist at Hunting Island State Park and participated in the South Carolina Arts Integration Initiative.
- * Isabel Goldvarg will be the instructor for two weeks of Fiesta Latino Americana. Mrs. Goldvarg, a native Spanish speaker, originates from Cali, Colombia, South America. She currently teaches Spanish to all program levels at ECMS.

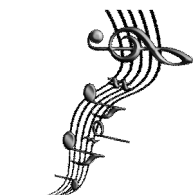
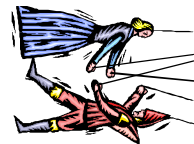
